



Dear Prospective Confirmation Candidate and Parents,

Congratulations on completing your eighth-grade year. I wish you nothing but the best as you prepare to enter high school and face the many exciting opportunities that await you.

As ninth-graders you are eligible to enter the Confirmation program. This is a decision that you will need to make after prayerful consideration and discussion with your parents.

If you wish to enroll in the Confirmation Program, I ask that you fill out the registration form and return it with the payment no later than August 1st. Feel free to mail the form back, drop it in the collection basket at Mass, or bring it to the rectory office.

The Confirmation program is designed to "put into action" what it means to be a Catholic Christian; namely, service to God and one another. There will be 10 sessions/activities that you will need to attend. These sessions span from September through May. A detailed schedule is attached.

In addition to the 10 sessions, Confirmation students are asked to attend Mass each week.

The Sacrament of Confirmation will be administered in the Fall of your tenth-grade year. (Date to be announced)

Students who will be attending a Catholic high school should make an appointment to speak with me. Your course of study will be different.

It is my hope that you will find the Confirmation Program rewarding and helpful as you grow to become the future leaders of our Church.
